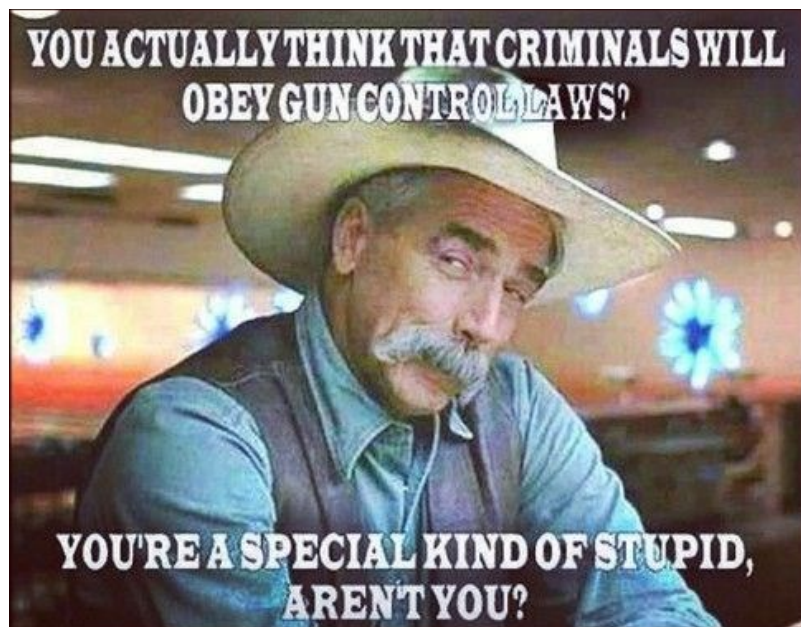

Proposed By-Law Change

(change are notated in red)

SECTION 4. DUES: Dues for Full Membership shall be Seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) for each fiscal year. Any increase in dues enacted during a year will not take effect until the beginning of the next fiscal year. Dues are to be paid by July 31 at the current stated amount; dues paid August 1 through September 30 will have a penalty of ten dollars (\$10.00) added. On October 1, if dues have not been paid, membership will be terminated. Junior Members, Probationary Members, Life Members and Honorary Members do not pay annual dues. Inactive Members will pay fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per year ~~to cover the cost of receiving The Ramrod.~~ Members wishing to receive the Ramrod though USPS instead of email will pay a fee of \$35.00 to cover the cost of the printing and mailing.
